

PROGRAM FUNDING

In compliance with the Stevens Amendment, funding details for Program Year 2024, July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025, are provided as follows:

- The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Adult Program is supported by the U.S. Department of Labor. A total of \$1,050,778, or 100% of the program, is financed with federal funds, and \$0, or 0%, is funded by other sources.
- The WIOA Dislocated Worker Program is supported by the U.S. Department of Labor. A total of \$882,781, or 100% of the program, is financed with federal funds, and \$0, or 0%, is funded by other sources.
- The WIOA Youth Program is supported by the U.S. Department of Labor. A total of \$1,073,918 program or 100% of the program, is financed with federal funds, and \$0, or 0%, is funded by other sources.
- The WIOA Economic Security for All Program is supported by the U.S. Department of Labor. A total of \$133,621, or 4% of the program, is financed with federal funds, and \$3,137,905, or 96%, is funded by other sources.
- The WIOA QUEST Disaster Recovery National Dislocated Worker Program is supported by the U.S. Department of Labor. A total of \$729,663, or 100% of the program, is financed with federal funds, and \$0, or 0%, is funded by other sources.
- Three Rivers Community Foundation awarded the BFWDC and WorkSource Columbia Basin \$2,000 to purchase laptops for customer use. 0% is funded by federal funds, \$0, or 0% is funded by other sources.
