

## PROGRAM FUNDING

In compliance with the Stevens Amendment, funding details for Program Year 2023, July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024, are provided as follows:

- The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Adult Program is supported by the U.S. Department of Labor. A total of \$699,721, or 100% of the program, is financed with federal funds, and \$0, or 0%, is funded by other sources.
- The WIOA Dislocated Worker Program is supported by the U.S. Department of Labor. A total of \$774,301, or 100% of the program, is financed with federal funds, and \$0, or 0%, is funded by other sources.
- The WIOA Youth Program is supported by the U.S. Department of Labor. A total of \$722,769, or 100% of the program, is financed with federal funds, and \$0, or 0%, is funded by other sources.
- The WIOA Economic Security for All Program is supported by the U.S. Department of Labor. A total of \$596,932, or 25% of the program, is financed with federal funds, and \$1,885,255, or 75%, is funded by other sources.
- The WIOA QUEST Disaster Recovery National Dislocated Worker Program is supported by the U.S. Department of Labor. A total of \$729,663, or 100% of the program, is financed with federal funds, and \$0, or 0%, is funded by other sources.
- Three Rivers Community Foundation awarded the BFWDC and WorkSource Columbia Basin \$2,000 to purchase laptops for customer use.
